

Annual changes in Medicare enrollment, spending per beneficiary, and total spending, 1980–2014



In the chapter, average annual changes in spending, spending per beneficiary, and enrollment by decade are shown in Figure 1-8 (p. 14). Figure 1-A1 shows those changes annually from 1980 to 2014. While the growth in Medicare spending has generally fallen since 1980, in some years it increased.


